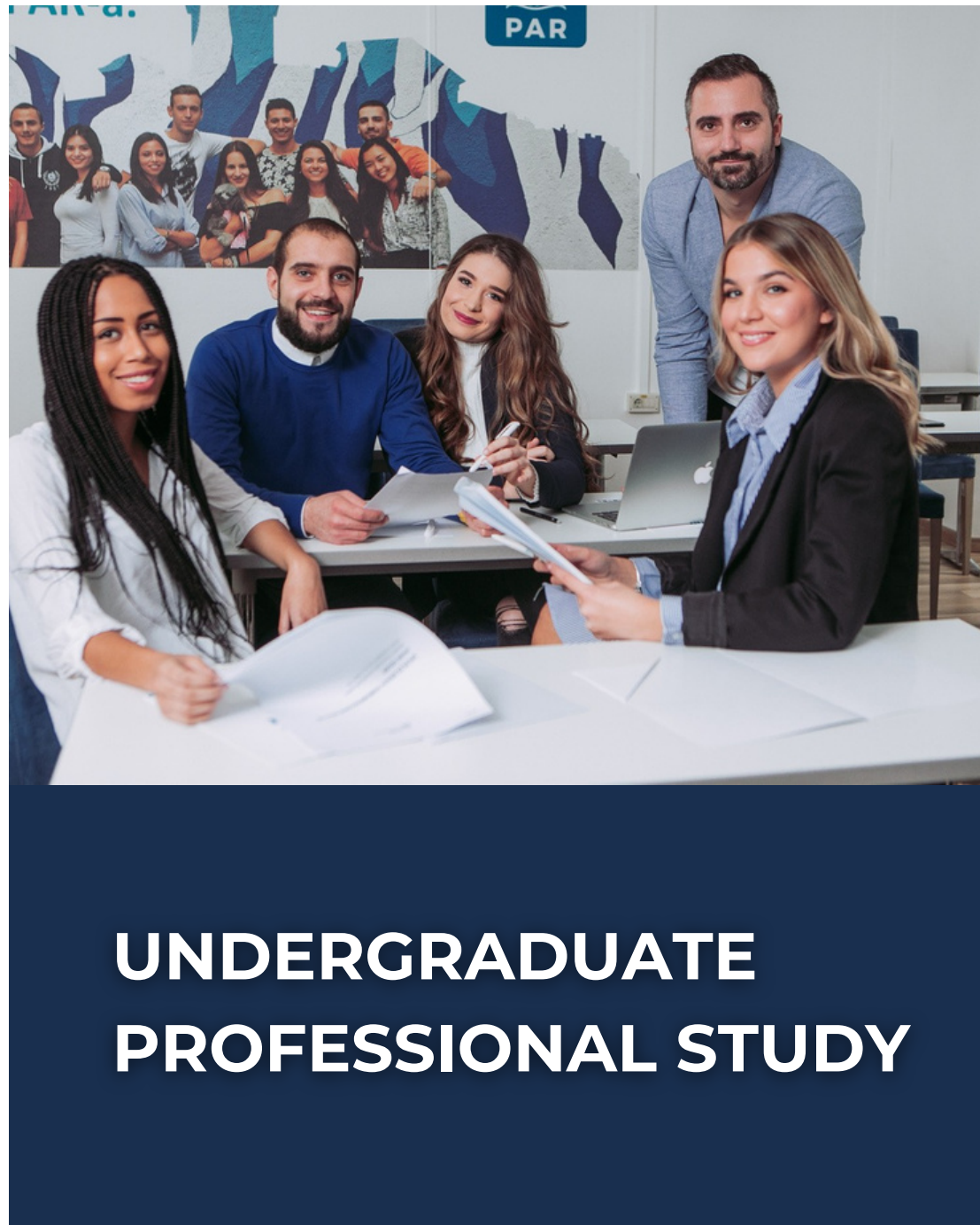

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

(three steps to studying at **PAR**)

1. NOMINATION

Before applying, students must be officially nominated by their home university. The partner university should send the nomination by email to erasmus@par.hr, including the following details:

Full name

Date of birth

Home university name

Current year of study

Once the nomination is received and accepted, students will be contacted with the application instructions and required documents.

Autumn/Winter Semester: **30 June 2026**

Spring/Summer Semester: **30 November 2026**

2. APPLICATION

Students who wish to apply must complete the application form and send the following documents to erasmus@par.hr:

- Completed application form
- Learning Agreement
- Copy of their passport or ID
- Health insurance card
- Two passport-size photos

Autumn/Winter Semester: **30 July 2026**

Spring/Summer Semester: **30 December 2026**

3. ACCEPTANCE LETTER

Once accepted, you'll receive an official Letter of Acceptance from us, confirming your participation in the Erasmus exchange programme.

VISA REQUIREMENTS

Non-EU students who wish to study in Croatia must obtain a student visa (Type D) before entering the country. To apply, you'll need a valid passport, an acceptance letter from the host institution, proof of sufficient funds, health insurance, a criminal record check, and a proof of accommodation. The application is typically submitted at the Croatian embassy or consulate in your home country.

OIB NUMBER Your first step in Croatia is to get an OIB

(Personal Identification Number), which is required for many official purposes. You'll apply for it at the local tax office, and our Erasmus coordinator will help you through the process.

TEMPORARY RESIDENCE PERMIT

To apply for your residence permit in Croatia, you'll need:

- A copy of your ID and health insurance card
- Your OIB (Personal Identification Number)
- An acceptance letter from PAR, stating your scholarship amount
- A tenancy agreement, signed by the apartment owner and notarized
- A residence registration form and supplementary form (available at the police station or International Office)

*Students from non-EU countries must also provide a student visa (if required), a passport-sized photo (3.5 x 4.5 cm), and pay a fee of approximately 90 EUR when applying for a temporary residence permit in Croatia.
